President Report: Debbie Van Veghel is in charge of Nominating Committee for 2019 Board Members: Vote will be held at Member meeting later tonight.

Vice-President Report: Speaker tonight is Ken Freeman, Coordinator of Hot Springs Parks and Trails program for the city of Hot springs. Discussed options for upcoming Holiday party on December 13, 2018. Options presented consisted of return to DeSoto Club or Rolando's. The Board voted to hold the event at the DeSoto Club. Trail Maintenance: Ralph reports that nothing much has changed. Not much participation. Recommendation was made that our section of the OT be previewed periodically and decision made as to whether trail needs work. Perhaps make it a special activity rather than a monthly event.

Webmaster: Website is up to date.

Historian: Ernie questions the necessity of maintaining history as it is already on our website via hike reports, etc. He has been unable to locate the Club's Shutterfly Photo books. Per Ernie, "I also question the need for a historian position as it exists on the Web site. Tom Calhoun is putting together a history link for the web site. And with the elimination of the historians position it would be one less member to recruit to the board. And if the position is kept the job description needs to be completely redone to reflect our current operation."
